Submission Information:

Reports for participation in the conference must be submitted by April 11, 2025. Articles are accepted in Kazakh, Russian, or English, and the text should not exceed 5 pages. An electronic collection of conference proceedings will be published based on the materials submitted.

Publication is free of charge.

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Requirements for Report Preparation:

- Font: Times New Roman, size 14, paragraph indent – 1.0.
- Line spacing: 1.
- Margins: 20 mm on all sides.
- For Kazakh reports: Italicized summaries and summaries in Russian and English should be included on the next line.
- For Russian reports: Summaries in Kazakh and English.
- For English reports: Summaries in Kazakh and Russian.
- Report submission: Electronically via email (file name should match the first author's surname).
- References: Listed at the end of the text after a single space.

NOTE:

To ensure the quality of published materials and protect intellectual property rights, all submitted articles must undergo mandatory plagiarism checks. Materials submitted for the collection must include a plagiarism report confirming at least 70% originality.

The conference proceedings are typeset directly; thus, it is crucial to provide articles in a carefully edited form following the stated requirements. Articles by students are accepted for publication only in co-authorship with their scientific supervisors.

Late submissions, non-compliant materials, or those with originality below 70% or without a plagiarism report will not be considered and will not be returned to the authors.
