Forms of participation: full-time, part-time, without specifying the form of participation in the collection of articles (the collection is included in RINC/e-library).

Articles are accepted on a free of charge basis within the specified period.

PAPERS REQUIREMENTS

The texts of the papers shall be submitted to the Editorial Board of the Volume in the electronic version in the RTF format.

File name: «Name, short name of the article».

The papers shall be accepted in Kazakh, Russian and English languages and shall meet the following requirements:

- in the left upper corner, the IRSTI and UDC shall be necessarily indicated;
- Full name, academic title and degree, position and place of work/study of the author are to be indicated on the top line of the article in the center and must be typed in lowercase letters. In case an article has more than one author, the full name, academic title and degree, position and place of work/studies of each author shall be recorded consecutively by a comma;
- the title of the article should be typed in capital letters in bold (12 pt of the title font) and aligned in the center, no dot is placed at the end of the title;
- then an abstract (typed in italics, from 800 to 1000 characters with spaces) and keywords (at least three) in Russian/Kazakh and English without a paragraph indent shall follow;
- allowable size of the article is from 10 000 to 40 000 characters (with spaces) - approximately from 5 to 15 pages of typewritten text;
- page parameters: left margin - 2 cm; right margin - 2 cm; top margin - 2 cm; bottom margin - 2 cm;
- font Kz Times New Roman (Kazakh), Times New Roman (Russian, English);
- font size - 12, interval - 1, alignment - page width;
- the paragraph indent begins with the fourth character of the line (0.9 cm);
- references to sources in the text (in the sequence of the author's references to the used sources) are arranged in square brackets with the page indication according to GOST 7.1-2003 «Bibliographic record. Bibliographic description. General requirements and compilation rules»;
- when typing text, you should not make a rigid transfer of words with the transfer sign;
- Connotations and abbreviations occurring in the text should be disclosed when they first appear in the text;
- general references to used literature and normative sources are given at the end of the article in Arabic numerals without dots under the title «List of used sources»;
- tables, graphs, diagrams, formulas and other graphic materials in the text should be numbered through each type of graphic material separately in accordance with GOST 7.1-2003 «Bibliographic record. Bibliographic description. General requirements and rules of compilation».

Presented text should be carefully edited in accordance with these requirements. Manuscripts and electronic media are not returned, nor are they reviewed or restored.

The author (authors) is responsible for the content of paper.
