## Educational and innovative complex "ITIS" in the educational process of the Chair "Finance"

The idea of creating electronic government was initiated by the head of state in the annual Message to the people of Kazakhstan on the republic becoming one of the fifty most competitive countries in the world. The e-taxes system is an integral part of e-government and currently exists as the IS ITIS RK.

In this joint project of the university and the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the ITIS RK program was introduced - the Integrated Tax Information System of the Republic of Kazakhstan, designed to comprehensively automate the activities of the tax committees of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

The goal of the joint project is the formation of innovative thinking among students and the development of their skills in the preparation by the university of highly qualified specialists for tax authorities in agreed specialties and training programs based on the introduction and use of electronic informational developments in the field of taxation in the educational process (software).

The training process - is carried out in a specialized office of PEC "INIS", equipped specifically for conducting classes in tax disciplines. The presence of 20 new computers and a server provides students with training in the skills of practical mastering the taxation mechanism in Kazakhstan within the framework of special information programs developed and implemented in the tax system of the Republic of Kazakhstan that ensure the interaction of taxpayers with tax authorities.

In the learning process, students, working in the system, learn the functional features of each component of the system, their interaction between themselves and the structures of the information hierarchy, practically study the features of each of the subsections included in the system components, reproduce the real situation of the interaction of the tax system with taxpayers; deepen knowledge in such disciplines as "Taxes and taxation", "Finance", "Tax planning and control".
